### **Daily Payment**

As you may well remember, we discussed in the previous newsletter of the likelihood of the daily fees increasing. Please see below an extract of a letter being sent out to all members and their families in the next few weeks.

#### INCREASE IN DAY CARE MEMBERSHIP FEES

#### Dear Members and families,

It is with great regret that we have to inform you that from November 2022 we will have to increase our daily attendance fee from its current £10 per day to £12.50 per day.

We have tried to postpone this for as long as we can but due to the increased costs for fuel, energy and food, amongst other costs we incur, this is no longer possible. The daily cost for attending the Centre has not risen in over ten years but unfortunately neither has the block grant we receive from East Lothian Council which previously helped to absorb most of these costs.

Unfortunately, we feel we have no other option at present in order to maintain the high level of service which you deserve. I would also like to assure you that this will not affect the activities we provide as these are all paid for from charitable donations which are dedicated for members use only.

I understand that this is a concerning time with the rise in energy and food costs, affecting us all, and a member of staff or myself are always available if you wish to discuss this privately with one of us.
