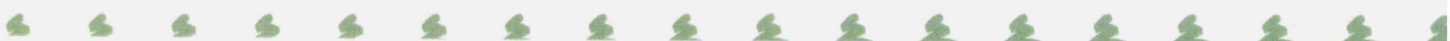

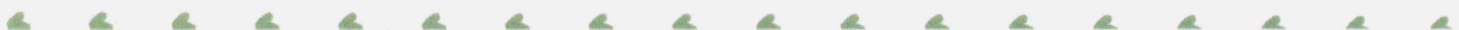
Our first day back after New Year is Tuesday 3rd Jan 2023 and we are back with a bang – Ne'er Day Party.
